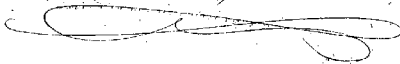

KNOW YE, That James Coppock, of Miami County,

having deposited in the General Land-Office a certificate of the Register of the Land-office at Cincinnati, whereby it appears that full payment has been made for the South West quarter of township nine, of Township four, in Range six, (East of the Meridian line)



of the lands directed to be sold at Cincinnati, by the act of Congress, entitled "An act providing for the sale of the lands of the United States in the territory north-west of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky river," and of the acts amendatory of the same, There is granted, by the United States, unto the said James Coppock, the quarter lot or section of land above described: To have and to hold the said quarter lot or section of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said

James Coppock, his heirs and assigns forever.
